

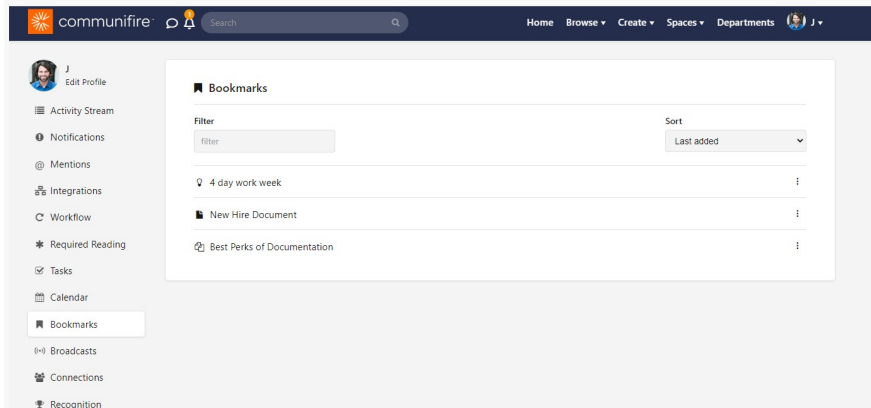

In My Bookmarks, you can view, search for, edit, and delete bookmarks.

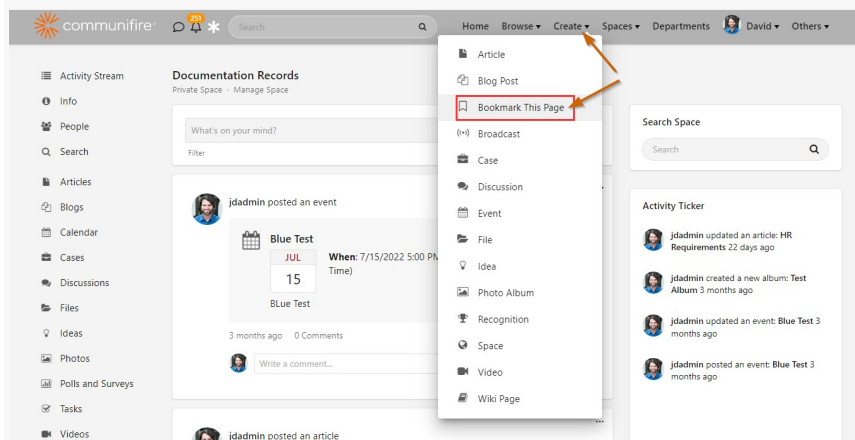

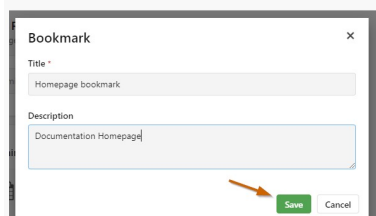

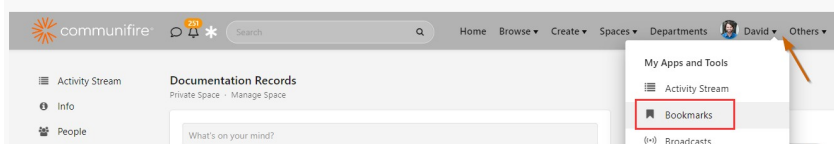
1. Go to page you want to bookmark. Click on **Create** dropdown and click **Bookmark This Page**.

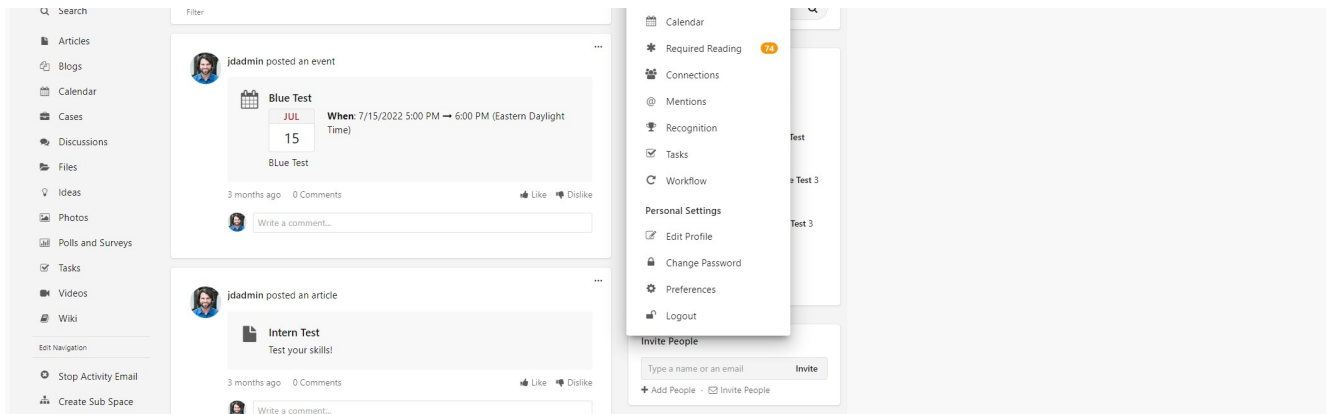


2. Enter **Title** and **Description** (Optional) and click **Save**.

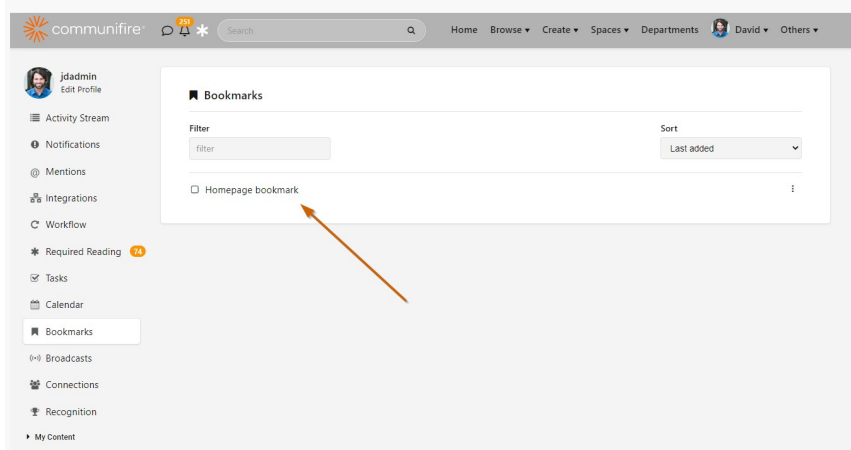


3. Click on your profile image arrow, then select **Bookmarks**.





4. Your bookmark is saved here.

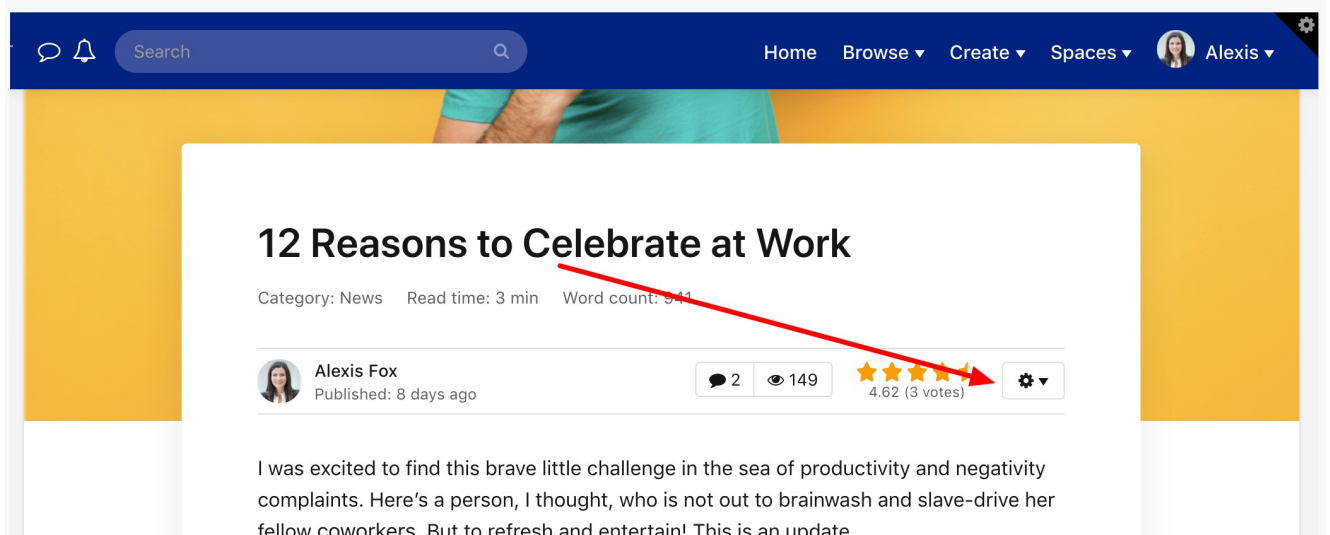
