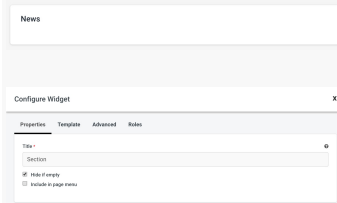

Use the section widget to organize your Page Builder page into sections.



Properties

Property	Description
Title	The widget title appears at the top of the widget
Hide if empty	Check to hide this section if it is empty
Include in page menu	Check to include a link to this section in the section menu widget
Use logged in user's first name as widget title	Check to display the user's first name as the widget title
Alphabetical sorting	Check to automatically alphabetize the widgets in the section

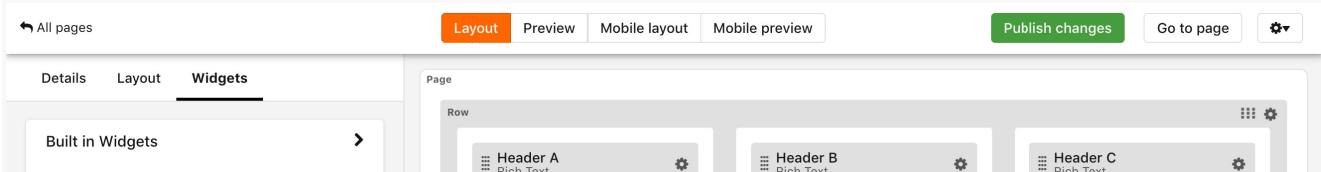
Field	Description
Icon	Select an icon to display with the widget (Requires a template that uses <code>[[ContentSection]]</code>)
Custom CSS class	A CSS class to append to the widget
Show Header	Check to show the widget's header, which includes the title
Show Footer	Check to show the widget's footer
Hide Container Border	Check to hide the widget's border
Open content in modal	Turns the section widget into a button that, when clicked, will open a side modal containing the widgets inside the section See How to Create a Side Modal for an example
Use logged in user's avatar as foreground image	Uses the logged in user's avatar as the button Note: Only available when "Open content in modal" is checked, and requires a template that uses <code>[[Context.ForegroundImageURL]]</code> .

Roles

Choose the roles that can view this widget.

Expand/Collapse Section Widget

When a Page Builder page is published, Section widgets will collapse to hide the widgets inside it. To expand or collapse a Section widget, click the gear icon on the Section widget > Expand/Collapse.
