Admin View	Allow the user to enter the Control Panel area for this section
Update All	Allow the user to edit any Page Builder pages
Delete All	Allow the user to delete any Page Builder pages
Manage Permissions	Allow the user to edit Page Builder permissions

- 2. Click Add User Role.
- 3. Enter Page Builder Editor as the role name.
- 4. Enter a description.
- Click Save.

- 7. Check the View Admin Section permission for the Page Builder Editor role.
