Required Parameters	How to use	Description
API Key	Used in the request URL: &token=x OR Set in header: request.Headers.Add(Rest-Api-Key, x)	Communifire REST API key for the Communifire portal you are making the call for.
UserID	&UserID=x - Used in the request URL as a query parameter	Unique ID of the user accepting the request.
ConnectionUserID	&ConnectionUserID=x -Used in the request URL as a query parameter	Unique ID for the user who sent the connection request.
