
Go to https://console.firebase.google.com.




Enter name of your Android application.










Enter the Android package name (Bundle ID) of your application, it should be same for Android and iOS.







Click **Download google-services.json file** and submit the file in a private case <u>here</u>.









Copy the Server key and include it in your private case.







NOTE
