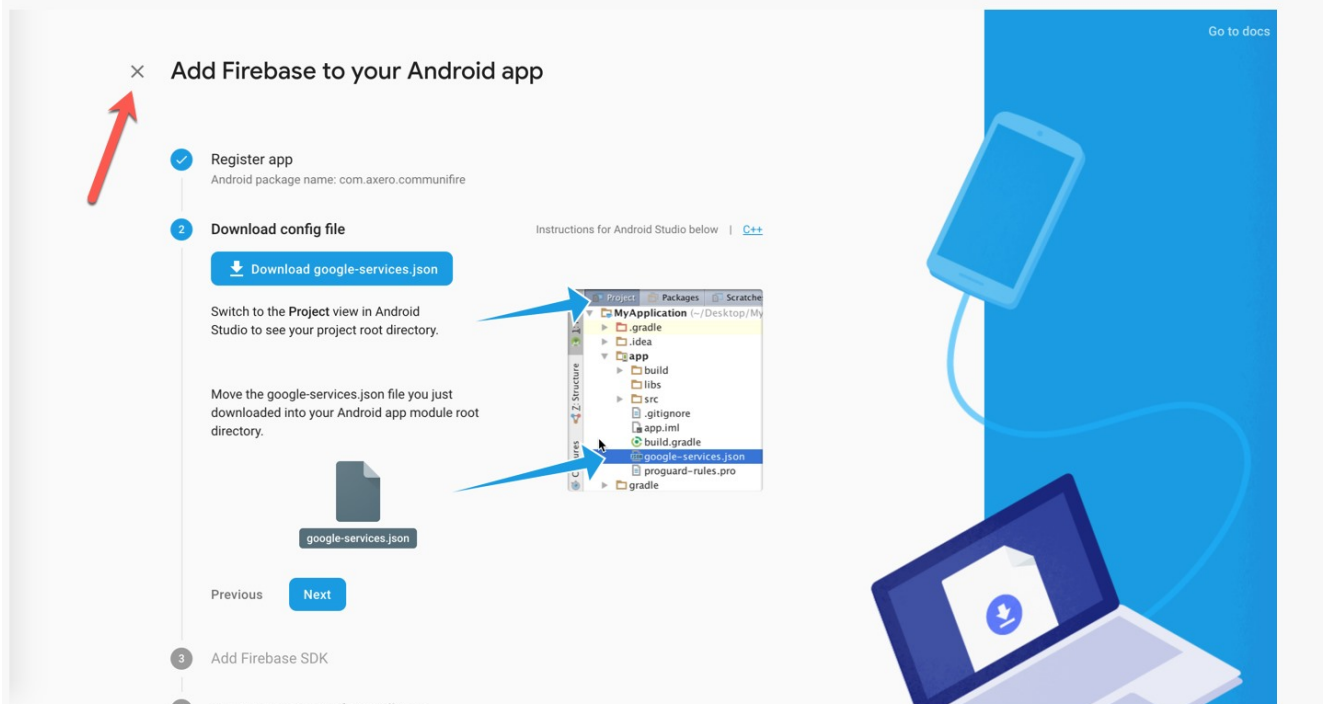


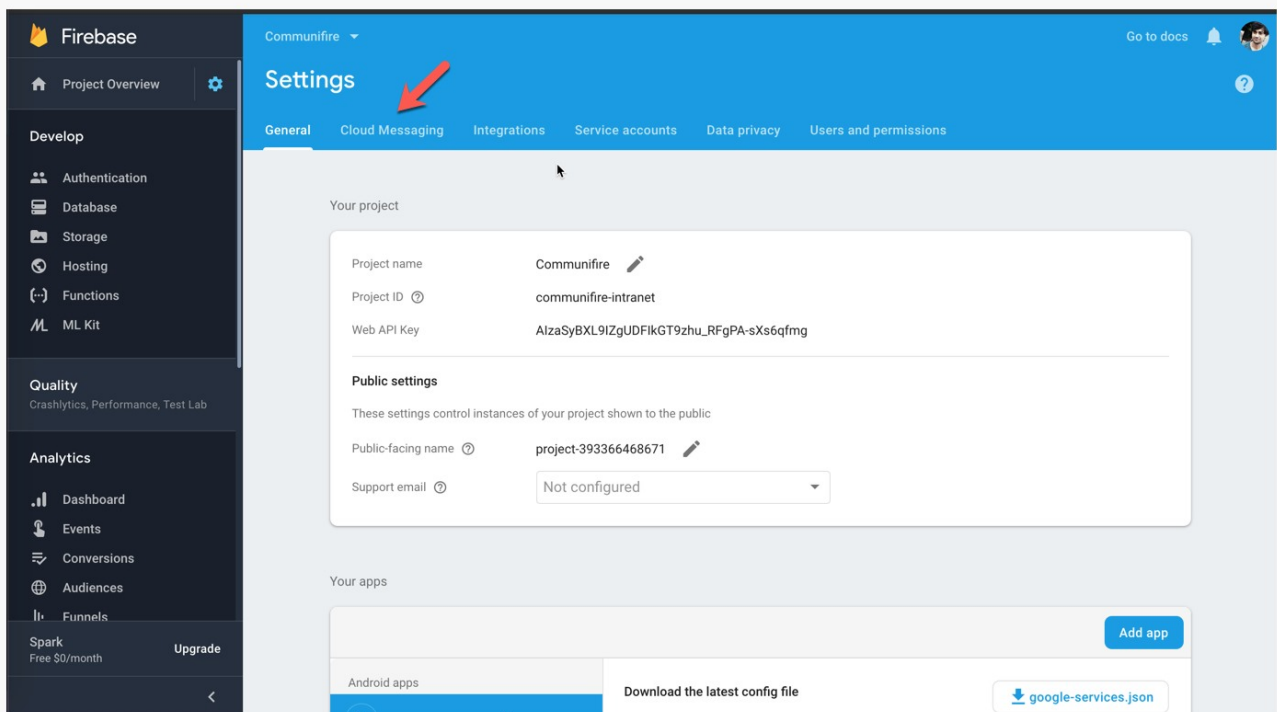
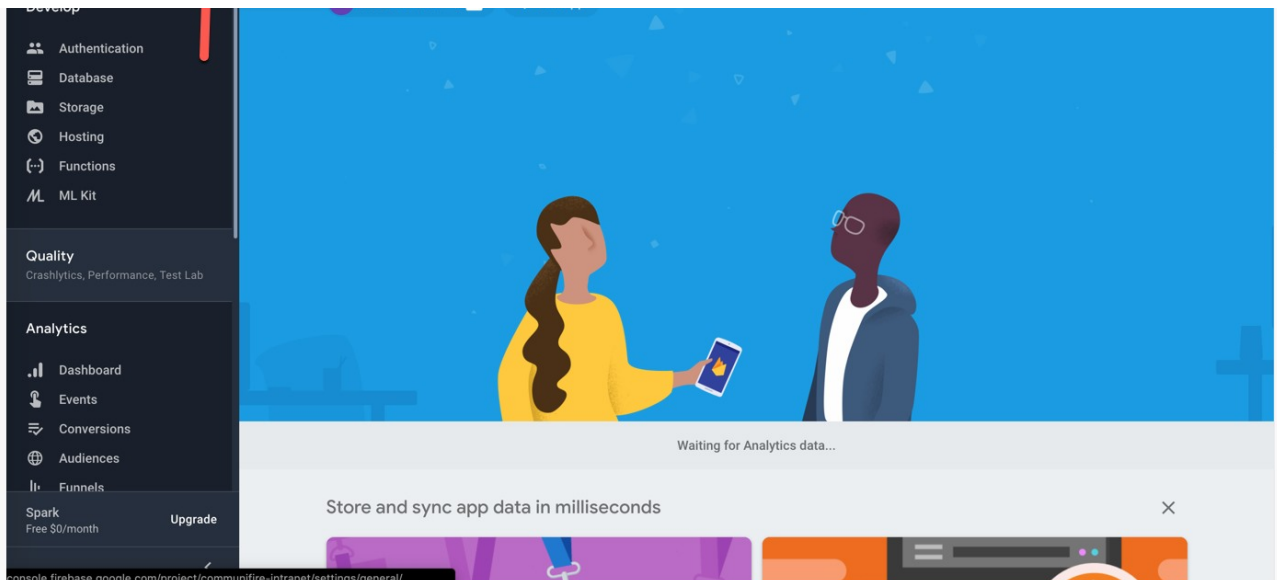
Enter the **Android package name (Bundle ID)** of your application, it should be same for Android and iOS.



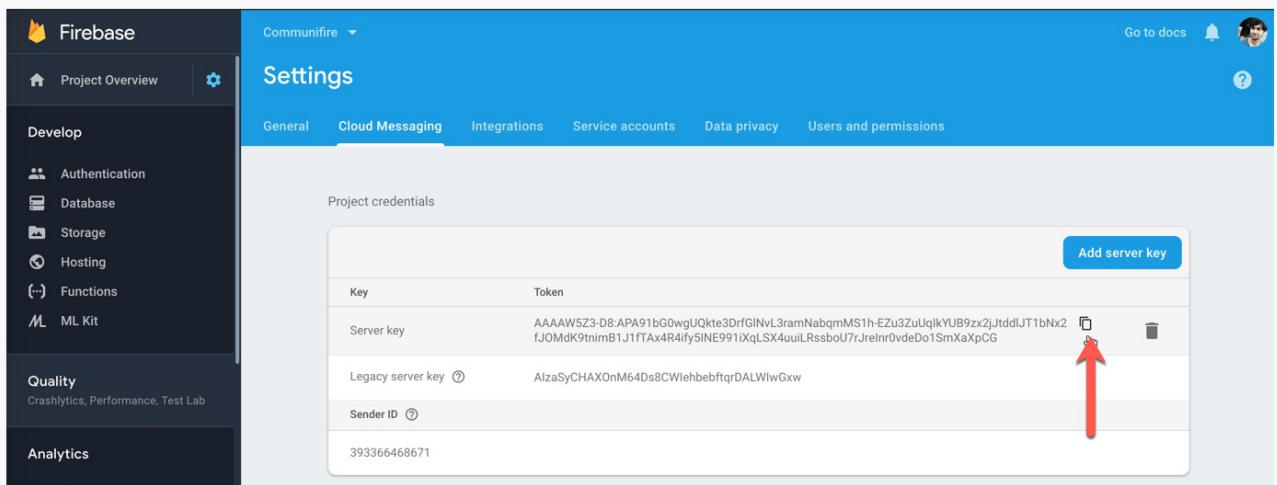


Click **Download google-services.json** file and submit the file in a private case [here](#).





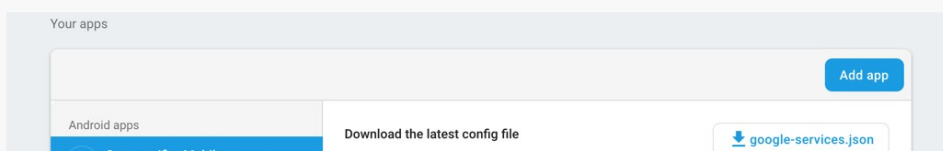
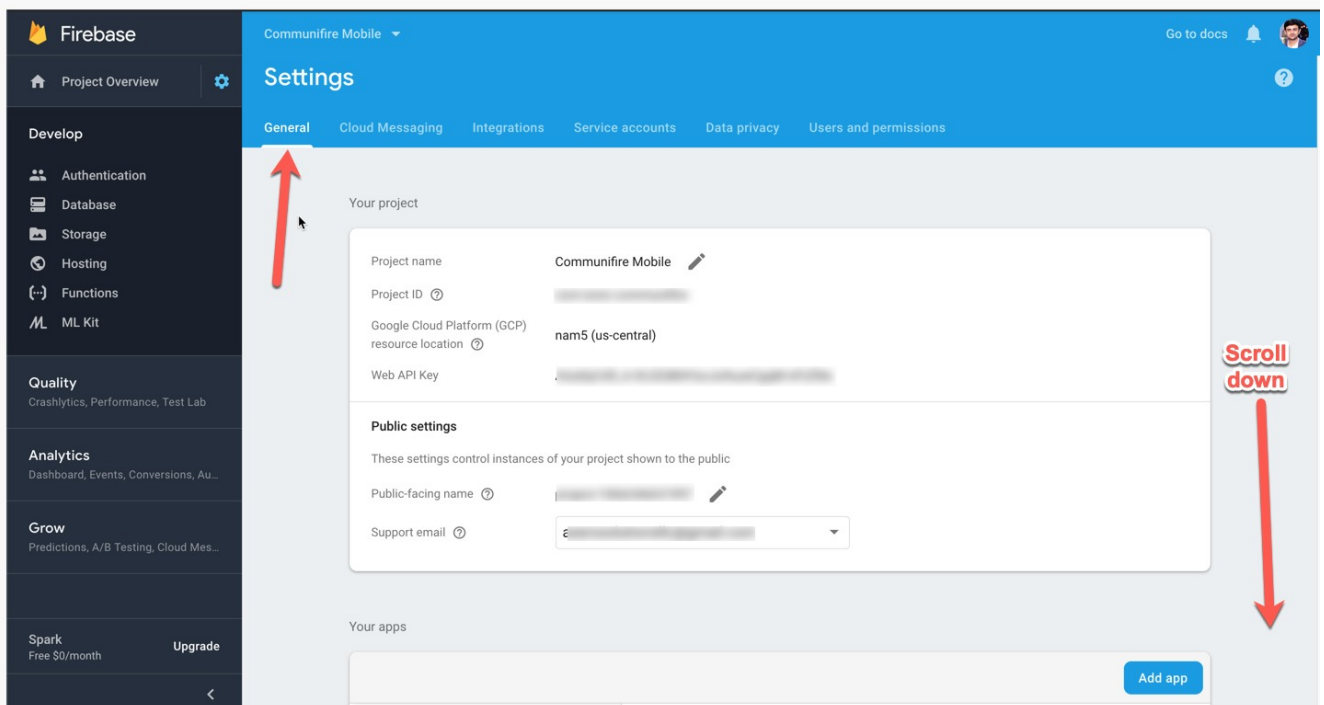
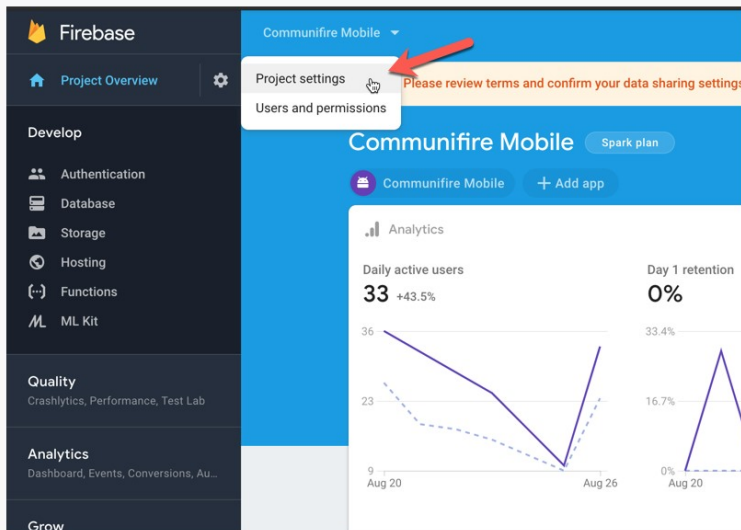
Copy the **Server key** and include it in your private case.
