




How to Add an Image to a Page Builder Page

Version 7

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Add an image to a Page Builder page using [Dynamic Properties](#) and a [Dynamic Property Widget](#). The image can be used on multiple Page Builder pages. When you want to update the image, you only need to update the dynamic property in the Control Panel, and the image will be updated everywhere it appears.

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Note: If you don't have access to the Control Panel, see [How to Add an Image to a Space Page Builder Page](#) instead.

Add Dynamic Property

1. Click the gear icon > **Control Panel** > **System** > **Dynamic Properties**.
2. Click **Add Category**.
3. Enter *Page Builder Content* as the **Name**.
4. Click **Save**.
5. Click **Add Dynamic Property**.
6. Fill out the following:
 - **Property Name:** The name of the property. The name is for administrative purposes.
 - Check **Is Active**.
 - **Category:** Select the **Page Builder Content** category.
 - **Description:** Enter a description. The description is for administrative purposes.
 - **Value:** Add the image here.
7. Click **Save**.

Add the Widget to a Page

1. Click **System** > **Page Builder**.
2. Add or edit a page.
3. Click **Widgets**.
4. Drag a **Dynamic Property** widget onto the page.
5. On the Dynamic Property widget, click the gear icon > **Edit properties**.
6. Update the widget **Title**.
7. In **Choose a space**, select **Top level community**.
8. In **Choose a property**, select the dynamic property you created.
9. Click **Advanced**.
10. Uncheck **Show Header**.
11. Check **Hide Container Border**.
12. Click **Save Widget**.
13. Click **Publish changes**.
14. Click **Go to page**.

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
