Required Parameters	How to use	Description
API Key	Used in the request URL: &token=x OR Set in header: request.Headers.Add(Rest-Api-Key, x)	Communifire REST API key for the Communifire portal you are making the call for.
SpaceID	&spaceID=x - Used in the request URL	Specifies the unique id of a space.

Optional Parameters	How to use	Description
PageLength	&pagelength=x - Used in the request URL	Specifies the number of results to be returned per page.
PageNumber	&pagenumber=x - Used in the request URL	Specifies the page number to be returned.
