DELETE /api/file/directories/{filedirectoryid}

Deletes the existing file directory specified Directory ID. Returns JSON indicating whether or not the specified directory was actually deleted. Valid for Communifire version 5.2 and above.

API Key	rest-api-token: Used in the request URL or set in the POST data	Communifire REST API key for the Communifire portal you are making the call for.
DirectoryID	Used in the request URL (see above)	Unique identifier for a particular file directory.
