PUT /api/content/{ContentID}

Update existing content. List of supported entities: Articles, Blogs, CMS Pages, Albums, Wikis, Ideas, Forums, Forum Groups, Forum Topics, Forum Posts. Valid for Communifire version 5.2 and above.

Required Parameters	How to use	Description
APIKey	Used in the request URL. Required	Contains the REST API key for the Communication portal you are making the call for.
ContentID	Used in the request URL. Required	Unique identifier for a content. List of supported entities: Articles, Blogs, CMS Pages, Wikis, Ideas, Photos, Albums, Forums, Forum Groups, Forum Topics, Forum Posts.
ContentIDN	Used in the request URL as a path parameter. Used in the request body.	This is IDN for the requested content object that you are updating. This should be the format used below in the sample given.
Optional Parameters	How to use	Description
ContentFile	Used in the request body.	Content file of the entity to be updated.
ContentSummary	Used in the request body.	Content Summary of Articles, Blogs or Videos to be updated.
ContentBody	Used in the request body.	Content Body of the entity to be updated.
CategoryID	Used in the request body.	CategoryID of the Articles, Blogs, CMS Page entities to be updated.
ParentContentID	Used in the request body.	Used in Wikis, Forums, Forum Topics, Forum Posts to specify the parent content under which this content is updated.
ContentImageURL	Used in the request body.	Used in Wikis to specify the image.
IsPublished	Used in the request body.	Used to mark content as "Published". True - Mark the content as "Published".
RequiresInlineConfirmation	Used in the request body.	Used in Wikis, Articles, Blogs and other content types that support required reading, with the exception of Files. True - will require people who have already confirmed reading to re-confirm the new version was published. False - updated content version will be required reading only for those who have not yet confirmed the prior version.
