## Add Template

1. Click the gear icon > **Control Panel** > **System** > **Page Builder Templates**.
2. Click **Add a new template**.
3. In **Template Name**, enter *Custom Featured People*.
4. In **Widget Type**, select **Content List**.
5. In **Widget Sub Type**, select **Content List**.
6. In the editor, paste the following code.

7. Click **Save Template**.

## How to Use the Template

1. Add or edit a Page Builder page in **Control Panel > System > Page Builder**.
2. Click the **Layouts** tab and add a layout onto the page.
3. Click the **Widgets** tab.
4. Drag a **Content List** widget onto the page. This template is best used in mid-sized columns - between 4 and 6.
5. On the Content List widget, click the gear icon > **Edit properties**.
6. In **Content types**, select **User**.
7. In **Authors**, start typing a name, and select the user from the suggestions. Fill the **Authors** field with all the users you want to display in the widget.

8. Set **Total items** to the number of users in the **Authors** field or a greater value.
9. Click **Template**.
10. Select the **Custom Featured People** template.
11. Click **Save Widget**.
12. Click **Publish changes**.
13. Click **Go to page**.

## How to Customize the User Profile Fields in the Widget

You can edit the Page Builder template to customize which user profile fields appear in the widget. HTML and JavaScript knowledge is required.

1. Go to **Control Panel > System > Page Builder Template**.
2. In **Widget Type**, select **Content List**.
3. Click the **Custom Featured People** template.
4. In the editor, locate the following line. This line gets profile fields using the API.

```
url: "/api/content/" + {{ContentID}} + "?contentTypeID=15&fields=Occupation"
```

5. In the fields parameter, enter a comma-separated list of profile field names. Example:

```
url: "/api/content/" + {{ContentID}} + "?contentTypeID=15&fields=Occupation,Department,Phone"
```

6. Locate the following line. This line displays the profile fields in the widget.

```
document.getElementById(id).innerHTML = response.ResponseData.Occupation;
```

7. Update the right hand side of the expression to change the profile fields in the widget and how they appear. Example:

```
document.getElementById(id).innerHTML = `${response.ResponseData.Occupation} | ${response.ResponseData.Department} | ${response.ResponseData.Phone}`;
```

8. Click **Save Template**.
