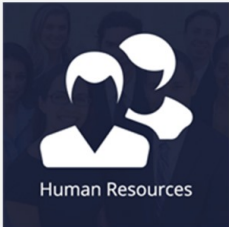

How to use the Image Link template

1. Add a [Button Widget](#) on a Page Builder page
2. Edit the widget
3. Configure the button link in the Properties tab
4. Click the Template tab and select the Image Link template
5. Click the Advanced tab
6. Click Foreground image and upload an image
