| Required Parameters | How to use | Description |
|---------------------|--|--|
| API Key | Used in the request URL: &token=x OR Set in header: request.Headers.Add(Rest-API-Key, x) | Communifire REST API key for the Communifire portal you are making the call for. |
| MessageId | Used in the request URL (see below) | Unique identifier for a particular message. |
| MessageBody | Used in the request body | The updated message that user wants to send. |
