Updates an existing event's view count using Event ID. Valid for Communifire version 5.2 and above.

Required Parameters	How to use	Description
API Key	Used in the request URL: &token=x OR Set in header: request.Headers.Add(Rest-Api-Key, x)	Communifire REST API key for the Communifire portal you are making the call for.
EventID	?eventid=x - Used in the request URL (see below)	Unique identifier for a particular event.
Event JSON	Used in the request body	This is JSON that represents an event object view count. This should be of the format seen below in the sample given.
EventCount	Used in the request body	Number of views you want to set for an event.
