## Create new wall post

### POST /api/wall

Saves a new wall post object in the Communifire database. Valid for Communifire version 5.2 and above.

Required Parameters	How to use	Description
API Key	Used in the request URL: &token=x OR Set in header: request.Headers.Add(Rest-Api-Key, x)	Communifire REST API key for the Communifire portal you are making the call for.
Wall Post JSON	Used in the request body	This is JSON that represents a wall post object that you're creating. This should be of the format seen below in the sample given. The required values in this JSON are given below.
WallText	Used in the request body	Text to be added as wall post.
Optional Parameters	How to use	Description
ToUserID	Used in the request body	ID of the user on whose wall you want to add the wall post.
SpaceID	Used in the request body	ID of the space in which you want to add a wall post
